What We Do ...

Strong Tower partners with Church of the Redeemer in Caracol to care for orphans in their community. We work towards reunifying families whenever possible; providing quality care in a culturally relevant facility; and moving

the project towards sustainability. Strong Tower Haiti can build two family-style duplex orphan homes, each housing 16-20 children and 2 sets of house parents. The first family home opened in June 2013.

Strong Tower Haiti is an integral part of the ministry and community of the Church of the Redeemer in Caracol. Within this faith community, the children served by Strong Tower receive physical, emotional and spiritual care as well as an education. They experience the love and grace of Jesus Christ. That love and grace is also extended to vulnerable children in Caracol through nutritional supplements, worm medication and clean water projects that are on going. Medical missions and a VBS program for the children are also a part of what we do.
