God is the One True God

Day 1

Meditate

Today we are focusing on God. We encourage you to start your day by reading Psalm 100:3 and meditate on this verse throughout this day.

Study

Sometime during your day read the story of Elijah on Mount Carmel found in 1 Kings 18:16-45.

How does this story of Elijah relate to our theme today?

We also encourage you to read the New Testament story of Paul's conversion found in Acts 9:1-20.

How does this story of Paul demonstrate God as being the One True God?

Worship

While you are listening to music today add Majesty by Kari Jobe and The Great I Am by New Life Worship to your queue.

Strengthen

1. What in life pulls you away from the One True God?
2. How should we worship the One True God?
3. Who is God to you?

God is my Protector

Day 2

Meditate

Today we are reflecting on God as our protector. Begin your day by writing down Hebrews 13:6. Refer back to that note throughout your day for encouragement and confidence in your Lord.

Study

During your day read the story of Daniel in the lions' den found in Daniel 6.

Did Daniel know the lions would not harm him?

Jesus calms a storm in Mark 4:35-41. Read the story and think about how you can relate to the disciples.

How did Jesus calm the storm? Does this action remind you of any other stories in scripture?

Worship

In your car, while working, or during your daily chores listen to Here Again by Elevation Worship and the hymn I Need Thee Every Hour.

Strengthen

1. Are there any situations in your life you are reluctant to praise God?
2. Do you trust God? Is there anything in your life you can't seem to release control of?
3. What is stealing your peace? Has it kept you from God or has it made you draw nearer.
4. Memorize Psalm 59:16

God is my Forever Friend

Day 3

Meditate

Good news! You are never alone! You have a friend in God. Read 1 Peter 5:7 and make a point throughout your day to confide in God.

Study

Sometime today read the story of Joseph found in Genesis 37, and follow the story with Genesis 50:20.

How does this story relate to today's theme?

What a powerful story Jesus crucifixion is; read Luke 23:26-49.

How does this story reveal Jesus as our forever friend?

Worship

Praise God today with these songs: Simple Gospel by United Pursuit, Better than Sunshine by Crowder, and the hymn Were You There by Jon Bryant.

Strengthen

1. When you think about names for God, is friend one of the names you think of? Why or why not?
2. Think of a time you have been or felt alone. Reflect on how that time felt. Could God's presence cure loneliness?
3. Take time to walk today and acknowledge the long walk Jesus took carrying the cross. While walking, spend the time praying and praising.
4. Take communion today. What is the significance of communion in your life?
5. Now it's your turn to be a friend. Has someone been on your mind? Has an old friend's name come across your path a few times recently? Pray for that person, then take a step to reach out with a call, text, or snail mail.
